



The Sailability Regatta is open to anyone who races in Access, 2.4mR, Challenger, Sonar, SKUD, Artemis and Laser Stratos dinghies and whatever your level of ability; from first time racers to Paralympic level sailors, the event promises to have something for everyone.

Race entry is just £10 per person and includes training on Friday, racing fee and Saturday evening dinner for competitors.

Friday's race training day includes, on-water and shore based training sessions for both new comers and more advanced sailors, with a barbeque to round off the day (tickets for BBQ £8.50 per person).

A full day of class racing takes place on the Saturday followed by an evening regatta dinner, as well as spot prizes for the day's notable performances, with the Ken Ellis Trophy race on Sunday. The weekend culminates with prize giving presentations with prizes for the top boats in the class and handicap races.
