THAMES BARRIER CONTROL ZONE ESTABLISHMENT OF FIXED WARNING NOTICE BOARDS

This Notice supersedes Notice to Mariners 15 of 2011 which is now cancelled.

New fixed warning notice boards have been established at the extremities of the Thames Barrier Control Zone in the following locations:

**Barking Point
Blackwall Point
Blackwall Stairs**

These fixed notice boards consist of symbology conforming to the United Nations/European Commission CEVNI code of signals for inland waterways. Please see the chartlet overleaf for a representation of the new signage.

On passing the fixed notice boards vessels are to navigate and make verbal reports to London VTS as specified within General Direction for Navigation in the Port of London 2011 number 27 – Navigation in the Thames Barrier Control Zone.

The interactive notice boards and flashing red/amber warning lights have been discontinued and removed.

Vessels are required to stop as prescribed in the regulations

A sign to indicate an obligation to enter into a radiotelephone link on VHF Ch 14 supplemented by an auxiliary panel providing additional information consisting of the telephone contact details of London VTS.
